Life changes began when I was in the 10th grade. I failed and had to repeat 10th grade. During the last week of my 11th grade year, the high school I attended told me that I was a senior. My school academic records indicated that I was a junior - not a senior.

The school informed me that I could not graduate in that I needed five additional credits. They determined that I was too old to continue in high school since I had just turned 18 years old.

Afterwards, it was suggested that I try another program. In that program, I spent an entire year working and

earned only one (1) credit. I later found out that all of the work that I had done had no value toward graduation.

Later that year, my mom became ill. I quit school, as I had to take care of my Mom for a year. My Mom passed on my birthday. I became deeply depressed and I decided to take a longer break to recover mentally.

When the new school year began, I returned to high school. Eventually, my father remarried and my stepmother suggested that I apply for Job Corps because she heard about the trades and skills that were offered. Once Job Corps accepted me, I found out about SALTech and I decided that SALTech was a better option for me rather than the other option of receiving a GED.

At SALTech, I was able to work towards my high school diploma at a pace that fit me. Through challenges and struggles, I could complete my high school diploma in a year. The teachers and staff at SALTech truly believed in my success. I found out that SALTech was hiring due to the new expansion. I applied for an Administrative Assistant position and am now an employee who can experience SALTech in a completely new way!
